

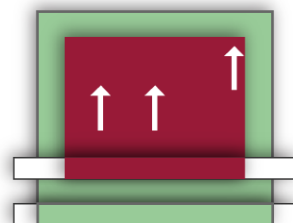
# BOARD BASTING

from **RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER**



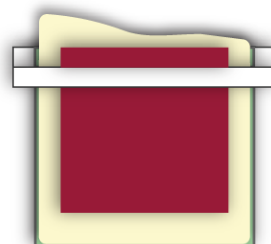
Lay out quilt top and back as desired. Make sure to have at least 4" excess back on all sides. Place first board approximately 6" from bottom of quilt top.

Roll quilt top tautly and evenly around board, flipping board upward, until it is completely wound. Repeat with quilt back.



Rotate boards 180°. Unroll approx. 18" of quilt back, flipping board upward. Cover with batting, lining up bottom and side edges, smoothing the entire surface. Spray baste if desired.

Place board with quilt top 4" from bottom edge of quilt back. Begin to unroll slowly, smoothing and holding board taut with each flip. When boards are even, stop unrolling and baste the area.



Continue unrolling and basting quilt sandwich 18" at a time, allowing basted area to fall over table edge and keeping boards straight and taut for support.
