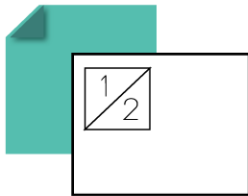


PAPER PIECING

Cheat Sheet

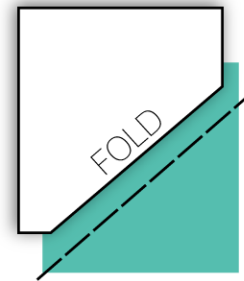
----- ONE TIME ONLY! -----



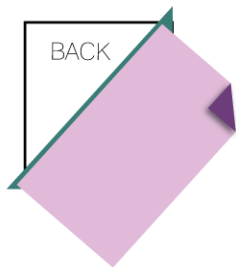
Place shape #1 over fabric, wrong sides together, covering shape completely with at least 1/2" overlap on all sides. Pin fabric to shape.

----- THEN -----

Fold paper back along line between shapes #1 and #2 (the next line you'll sew).

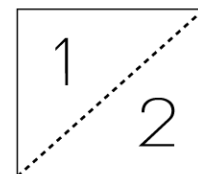


Trim excess fabric to 1/4". Unfold paper to flat and flip over.



Place fabric #2 along trimmed edge (and future seam line) on back of paper, right sides together, ensuring fabric will cover shape #2 with 1/2" overlap when pressed open. Pin and flip paper over.

Sew along the line between shapes #1 and #2, stay-stitching on either end of the line. Remove pins and press open.



Repeat folding, trimming, placing, stitching, and pressing for all future shapes/lines. Follow the numbers! (Next up: line between shape #2 and #3, etc.)
